### GENERAL RULES FOR HELL WEEK

1. The pledges are required to obey actives at all times. The pledges are not to talk back or argue.
2. Pledges shall wear dresspants, and a dress light colored shirt--with an inch and half red ribbon tied in a bow for a tie.
3. Pledges shall provide themselves with an egg upon which he will have affixed 15 signatures of teachers. All names thereon must be listed on a sheet of paper so that he will be able to locate any name asked for. Signatures of teachers are well known, so do not try to forge any names.
4. Shoes shall be well shined at all times.
5. Socks shall be of two sorts and pants legs rolled up to expose socks.
6. Pledges must carry a shoe shine kit at all times to polish actives' shoes.
7. Hair should be parted in the middle and well greased. Hair can be combed back. Five swats for not having hair parted directly in the middle or greased enough.
8. When a pledge meets an active or actives, he should stop and address them by their last names--as "How do you do Mr. \_\_\_\_\_"
9. Pledges must refrain from smoking, drinking, dates, dancing, swearing, smutty talk, or shows.
10. Pledges must absolutely refrain from conversations with girls.
11. Pledges must meet at the house every night at 7:00 sharp.
12. Pledges must learn these rules, each rule must be quoted by number.
13. Pledges must shave every morning, all except the upper lip and goatee.
14. Pledges shall provide themselves with small notebook, about five inches long and two inches wide, in the book the actives shall mark name and number of swats to be received for failure to comply with the above rules.
15. Be able to sing the fraternity song and know the Greek alphabet.
16. Assignments and missions shall be given out at the evening meetings.
